



2019 USA Volleyball National Scorer Candidate Application Information, Instructions, & Checklist

1. All applicants must be in good standing in their respective regions from the time of application through the conclusion of the evaluation process. A current USAV background screen and SafeSport training must be on file in Webpoint at the time of application.
2. Candidate must register in Webpoint for National Scorer Candidate Curriculum and pay the \$150 fee.
 - a) The application fee will be refunded if the applicant is not accepted as a candidate.
 - b) If accepted as a candidate, current National Referees may request a \$50 refund by contacting Pati Rolf at pati.rolf@usav.org.
3. The official application must be submitted via email. It can be downloaded from the USAV Academy from the course 2018-19 National Scorer Candidate Application Materials, under Resources.
 - a) Paper copies of the application will not be accepted.
 - b) Electronic signatures are accepted.
 - c) When submitting the application use the subject line National Scorer Application – Your Name (e.g., National Scorer Application - Moore, Jane).
 - d) Email applications to Rachael Stringer at rstringer12@gmail.com and CC your region's commissioner, your region's scorer chair, and Pati Rolf at pati.rolf@usav.org.
 - e) Applications are due **April 1, 2019, at 11:59 PM Mountain Time**.
 - f) Notification of acceptance will be no later than **May 1, 2019**.
4. Failure to meet any of the above listed deadlines will result in disqualification from the National Scorer candidacy program this season.
5. If you are a current Junior National or National referee and intend on attending the Boys' Junior National Championships as a referee when not a scorer candidate, please register to officiate on VolleyballRefTraining.com at <http://www.volleyballreftraining.net/events.php> when it becomes available for registration. Include a note that you are applying as a National Scorer Candidate.
 - Please note that you will not referee any matches during the scorer evaluation process. If you are eligible for OCRP you must pay for one-half of the hotel room for the date of your evaluation.
6. The 2019 Boys' JNC will be held in Dallas, Texas, at the Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center from June 30-July 7. All candidates are required to check in at the playing venue by 7:00 PM the day before their evaluation. You must be available with no schedule conflicts during your one-day evaluation session which will be on **July 1, 2, or 3**. You may depart the event any time after 10:00 AM the day after your evaluation session, or you may stay to referee after the evaluation session has ended.
7. If you are part of OCRP during your candidacy, you must pay for your hotel room by **September 15, 2019**.

National Scorer Candidate Curriculum

Applicants for National Scorer certification are required to complete the National Scorer Candidate Curriculum. This must be completed by **May 31, 2019**.

For applicants who have already completed the modules or exams for their National-level certification requirements, it is not necessary to re-take these modules. We will verify your records in the USA Volleyball Academy to confirm completion of all requirements.

Instructions for Completing the National Scorer Candidate Curriculum

1. Log onto Webpoint at <https://webpoint.usavolleyball.org>.
2. Click on Event Registration to view the drop-down menu.
3. From the drop-down menu, click on USAV Ref/Score clinics.
4. Locate the National Scorer Candidate Curriculum and click REGISTER.
5. To access the Academy, log onto Webpoint and click, "Login to USAV Academy."

Tips for taking courses/exams

- Make sure your Flash Player is up to date and running.
- Make sure pop-ups are not blocked on your computer.

When having issues with a course/quiz/exam

- Clear your browser history and restart your computer before resuming your exam/course.
- Attempt to access the material using a different web browser.
- Attempt to access the course material via another computer.
